The detailed Time Table for conduct of First MBBS Theory Supplementary Examinations scheduled to be held from **05th May, 2022** is sent herewith.

The Principals of the respective Medical Colleges are hereby requested to display the Time Table prominently on their notice boards for the information of the students and also inform the contents of references 2nd & 3rd cited regarding the **one time relaxation given to students of First MBBS for the eligibility criteria to appear in University Examinations with regard to:**

1. Internal Assessment Marks – 40% instead of 50%
2. 5% relaxation in attendance – 70% for Theory and 75% Practicals instead of 75% Theory & 80% for Practicals (ref. 2nd cited)

SPECIAL NOTE TO 2019 BATCH STUDENTS	As per the NMC, New Delhi, Regulations under Rule No.11.2.7 For 2019 Admitted Batch onwards, no more than four attempts shall be allowed for the candidate to pass FIRST PROFESSIONAL examinations. The total period for successful completion of first Professional course shall not exceed four (4) years. Partial attendance of examination in any subject shall be counted as an attempt. A learner shall not be entitled to Graduate later than ten (10) years of her/his joining the first MBBS course.

INSTRUCTIONS TO THE STUDENTS

1. All the students of FIRST PROFESSIONAL shall abide by the Regulations of Competency Based Curriculum of the Medical Graduate Programme as prescribed by National Medical Commission, New Delhi.

2. **Passing in FIRST PROFESSIONAL is compulsory before proceeding to PHASE- II training. As prescribed in the Medical Council of India Regulations on Graduate Medical education, 1997, clause 8 passing in First Professional is compulsory before proceeding to Second MBBS training. It is to inform all the students that unless the students pass successfully in the First MBBS examination they will not be promoted to Second MBBS.**

Moreover, if a candidate has failed to pass in the supplementary examination he/she will have to repeat the 1st MBBS course curriculum and appear for the University examination of 1st MBBS with the new batch.

3. **As per the NMC, New Delhi, Regulations under Rule No.11.2.7 For 2019 Admitted Batch onwards, no more than four attempts shall be allowed for the candidate to pass FIRST PROFESSIONAL examinations. The total period for successful completion of first Professional course shall not exceed four (4) years. Partial attendance of examination in any subject shall be counted as an attempt. A learner shall not be entitled to Graduate later than ten (10) years of her/his joining the first MBBS course.**

THEREFORE, STUDENTS ADMITTED DURING 2019-20 AND APPEARING FOR THE FOURTH TIME (FOURTH PERMISSIBLE ATTEMPT), ARE HEREBY INFORMED THAT THIS WILL BE THEIR LAST CHANCE FOR COMPLETION/PASSING FIRST MBBS PROFESSIONAL EXAMINATIONS

4. All the students have to pay Marks memo fee along with the Examination Fee.

5. Candidates who pass this examination will be continued with the main batch. Failed candidates have to appear for examination with next regular batch (2021-22)

6. For 2018 and before admitted batches, if any candidate though eligible under normal Circumstances, but fails to register for any reason or is detained, it will be counted as an Attempt.

INSTRUCTIONS TO THE PRINCIPALS

1. **Digital Valuation of MBBS Theory Answer Scripts is being implemented from July/August, 2017 Examination onwards.** For further details College Principals, faculty and students concerned are requested to refer University Circular dated 27/07/2019 which is also available on the University website

2. Internal Assessment marks and Attendance particulars uploaded for January, 2022 examinations will be considered in respect of failed candidates and absentees only.
3. In case of students detained due to shortage of attendance for January, 2022 examination, classes to be conducted as being done for referred students during the interim period and the attendance should be uploaded/submitted on or before 16-04-2022.
4. As per Advisory dt.19-04-2021 of NMC, New Delhi, all the students who are unable to appear for the examinations for whatever reasons, may take up the examinations with supplementary batches. This will not be counted as an additional attempt for them subject to fulfillment of eligibility criteria in all aspects
5. In case of students detained due to securing < 40% either in theory and/or in practical & < 50% aggregate of the Internal Assessment Marks, fresh Internal Assessment has to be conducted and the marks are to be uploaded/submitted on or before 16-04-2022.
6. Fresh Internal Assessment and Attendance particulars of all the detained/not registered students of January, 2022 Examinations duly signed by Head of the Department and counter signed by the Principal should be uploaded/submitted on or before 16-04-2022
7. **The Internal Assessment Marks and Attendance once uploaded/submitted and frozen shall be final and no changes will be entertained later.**
8. The student is not eligible to appear for the University exam if he/she does not appear for Internal assessment exams or if the Internal assessment exam marks & attendance percentage are not uploaded/submitted on or before **16-04-2022**. In such case the candidate will be detained and no changes will be entertained later on.
9. **One time relaxation is given to First MBBS 2020 admitted batch only, for the eligibility criteria to appear in University Examinations with regard to:**
 1. Internal Assessment Marks – 40% instead of 50%
 2. 5% relaxation in attendance – 70% for Theory and 75% Practical instead of 75% Theory & 80% for Practical
10. The INTERNAL ASSESSMENT MARKS uploaded/submitted after the last date will not be considered for declaration of result for which the Principal is solely held responsible.
11. The Principal should verify all the filled data submitted/uploaded into the **MEdHAS PORTAL** for eligibility of students and submit to the Controller of Examinations on or before the specified dates. The Principal will be held solely responsible, if any ineligible candidates are permitted to write examination.

13. The Principals are advised to form a Committee with concerned Head of Departments under Chairmanship of Principal/Vice-Principal who shall be responsible for forwarding examination applications and releasing hall tickets as per eligibility.
14. Instructions/directions as issued previously by the University and Team MEDHAS for uploading of Internal Assessment, Attendance, Practical & Orals are to be adhered to scrupulously.
15. **While uploading the candidates details the Principal has to take care to see that the scanning of the Photo & Signature of the candidate is done in the given space visibly. The Signature of the student should be visible and legible. The signature should be done with black ink pen in the given space and size of the box only, so as to avoid the delay or last minute issue of Hall Tickets.**

16. **The details entered in MEDHAS Portal by the Principal are final and Hall Tickets will be issued accordingly.**
17. Competency Based Under Graduate Curriculum to be implemented from August, 2019 i.e., MBBS batch admitted in first year. Batches admitted and studying currently in MBBS shall continue with the existing Curriculum.
18. The Colleges should not collect Examination Fee from the Ineligible candidate such as who have failed in IA marks and who have shortage of attendance as per the Dr.NTR UHS/MCI Rules.
