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The fee shall be sent along with examination application, kindly arrange to send the Examination fee of all candidates through a consolidated demand draft in favour of the **Registrar, Dr. NTR University of Health Sciences, payable at Vijayawada.**

The eligibility to appear for these exams is:

- a) The PG Dental Degree students who took admission and whose admission are approved by the University during the academic year, 2017-18 and who shall complete **Three years** of study period (36 months) including period of examinations are eligible for the ensuing examination. The Principal concerned must submit study period completion certificate of the students.
- b) As per New Regulations of DCI, the PG Dental Degree students who took admission and whose admission are approved by the University during the academic year 2019-2020 and who shall complete 01 year course of study shall appear for MDS Part-I Basic Sciences.
- c) The PG Dental Diploma students who took admission into the colleges in Andhra Pradesh & whose admissions are approved by the University during the academic year, 2018-19 and who shall complete **two years** of study period (24 Months) including period of examinations are eligible for the ensuing examination. The Principal concerned should submit period completion certificate of the students.
- d) Attendance: Every candidate shall secure (80% attendance during each academic year)

The following copies of certificates shall be enclosed by the candidates to the application appearing for the MDS examinations.

- a) Evidence of the date of birth (SSC or its equivalent Examination Certificate) attested Xerox copy only.
- b) Two Testimonials from any two Lecturers of the college concerned.
- c) Attendance / Eligibility Certificate from the Principal
- d) The Candidates who are from outside the state should submit their Migration Certificate.
- e) Copy of BDS Original Degree (Attested Xerox copy only).

Unless these certificates are enclosed with the application the application will not be considered and there will not be any further correspondence with candidate.

University Examination:

Paper - I: Shall consist of one paper

There shall be a theory examination in the Basic Sciences at the end of 1st year of course. The question papers shall be set and evaluated by the concerned Department/Spaeicality. The candidates shall have to secure a minimum of 50% in the Basic Sciences and shall have to pass the **PART - I** examination at least six months period to the final (Part - II) examination.

Please also furnish the number of answer books required stock of answer books, practical work sheets and additional books available and advance amount required. **IF PREVIOUS ADVANCE IS NOT SETTLED, FRESH ADVANCE CANNOT BE SANCTIONED.
